

## WONDERS OF SOUTH AMERICA

### **Lima Tour, Days 1-2**

During your first days you will experience the soul of Lima with your private guided tour. Discover the San Francisco Convent and Larco museum; begin the visit of the city with an exploration of Colonial Lima. You will stop off at the Main Square, to explore it on foot and admire the exteriors of the Government Palace, the Cathedral, and the City Hall, all examples of Lima's still-present colonial architectural opulence.

### **Lima / Cusco / Sacred Valley, Day 3**

**Sacred Valley, Days 4-5**

**Sacred Valley / Machu Picchu / Cusco, Day 6**

Almost at the top observe the change of the landscape from green to red, and further discover the beautiful Rainbow Mountain.

### **Cusco / Puno, Day 8**

#### **Stay at Titilaka Hotel**

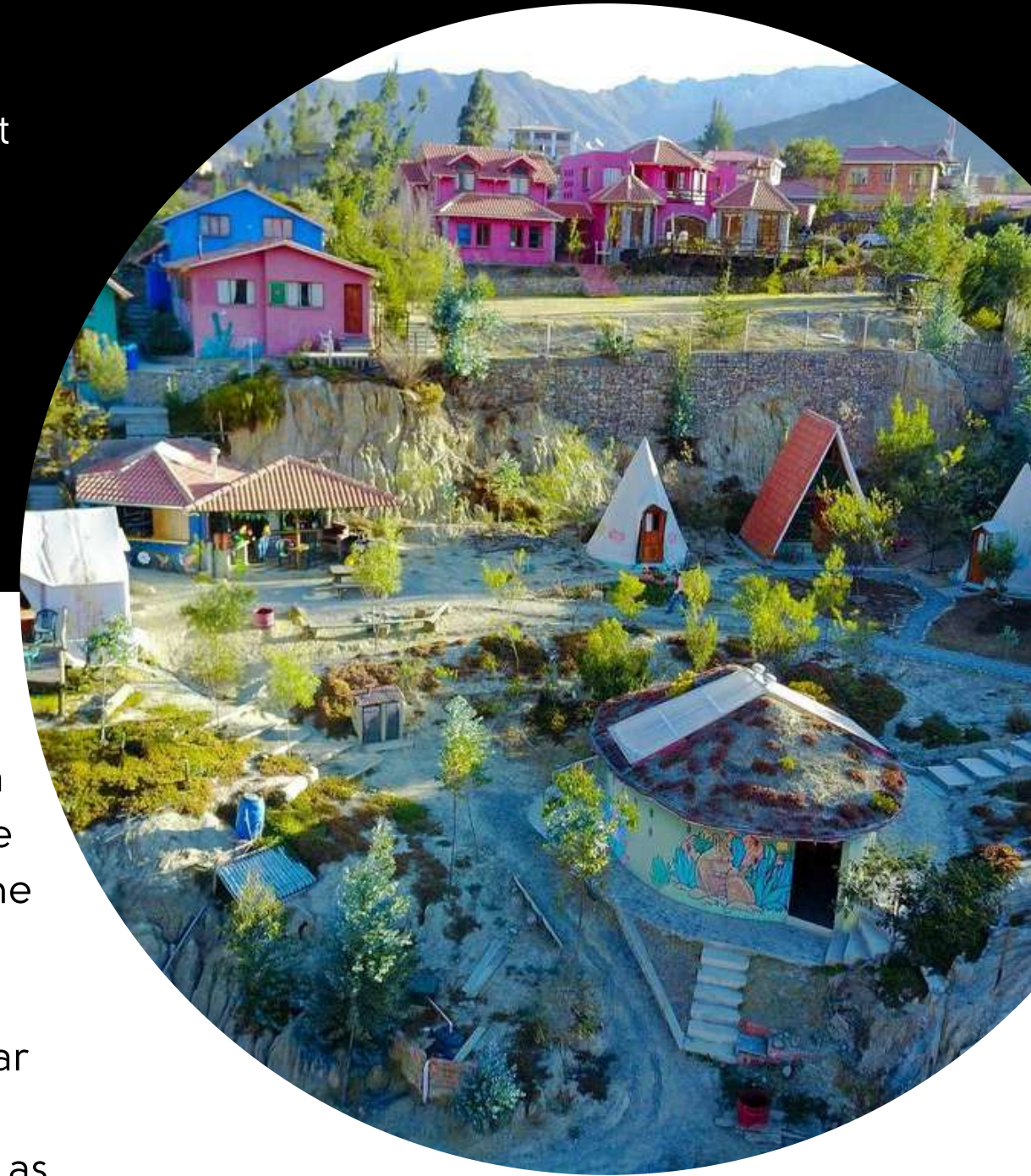




**Puno, Day 9**

**Stay at Casa Grande Hotel**

Today start your private luxury cruise on Lake Titicaca, flying you over the waves to Copacabana town in Bolivia. Upon arrival you stroll through the streets of the picturesque town at the shores of the Lake, where you find the most famous Virgin of Bolivia – the Mamita del Lago also called Indian Virgin. Thousands of pilgrims arrive during the year in order to give thanks or to make wishes for the upcoming year. Afterwards continue to highlights as and the Moon Island, from where you have an astonishing view of the mountain range and you get to be transported back in time, when the Inca maiden lived on the island, learning to be the perfect spouse and companion for the Inca Royalty.



### **La Paz, Day 11**

In the morning begin your private City Tour in comfortable vehicle with snacks and soft drinks on board. ### **La Paz / Uyuni Salt Lake, Day 12**

#### **Stay at Deluxe Airstream Campers**

You will be taken to the train Cemetery. Afterwards visit the small town of Colchani, where you will see a Salt processing factory, showing you the antique way of the processing being still in use. Also visit the Salt extraction process on the shores of the Great Salt Lake. Overland drive to Jirira town, on the north shore of Uyuni. Upon arrival to you will be served refreshments and you have time to enjoy the area and the flooded Salt Lake, taking pictures with your dedicated photographer.

Beverages is served at sunset with delicious finger food as well as warm and cold drinks.





### **Uyuni Salt Lake, Day 13**

Visits around the Salt Lake, drive along Uyuni shores for a visit to the Chiquini Cave (unique High-plateau Geology) and the Ayque Archeological Ruins with its Chullpas or Mummies.

In the afternoon you may visit Coquesa town and drive up the the Thunupa Crater in order to make bird's eye view pictures of the Great Salar.
